### We are now officially New Life Ministries

The Meal Ministry and the Womens Life House are now officially New Life Ministries. It has taken a little time to get all the work done for the merger. Both ministries will continue operating as they previously were. The Meal Ministry will continue to serve an evening meal to those in need in the community and the Womens Life House will continue to help women with shelter, food, sup-

port, and classes.

We are excited to see these ministries work together. The women from the Life House serve by volunteering at the Meal Ministry and in return the Meal Ministry supplies food to the Life House. Both ministries are now assisting each other to better serve the people in the community.

This last November we had a benefit auction and raised

\$4,800.00. We also did a mail out campaign to raise funds for these ministries. This campaign raised \$12,859.37. The yearly budget for these ministries is \$86,109.00.

We want to thank all who gave financial gifts in 2014. Your financial gifts are truly a blessing to the Meal Ministry and the Womens Life House. A sincere thank you to the partners for your faithfulness.
