MEET THE TEAM: LARRY YOUNG

Tell us a little about yourself.

I'm a member at New Life Fellowship Church and a person doing God's work. I have been working at the Men's Life House, part-time, for about 2 months now. Outside of the Men's Life House, I work doing heating and cooling, plumbing, and electrical.

Why did you decide to work at the Men's Life House?

With the experiences I have been through, I felt God was calling me to work here. I feel like I have a lot to offer because I have been through similar situations as some of the men in the house.

What does a regular day at work look like for you?

It depends on the day. On Fridays I help teach a class, I spend time interacting with the guys, review rules and regulations with the men, and when the house is empty I work on small maintenance projects.

What is the best part of this job so far?

Getting to minister to people and to those who knew me from my past. Those who knew me before are able to see how I have changed now. I used to look up to some of these guys when I was living differently and now they look up to me and the way I live now.

How has this job impacted you?

I am impacted daily by knowing I am doing God's work and that this is where my calling was. It has humbled me a lot, because I used to be in those same situations as some of the men in the house and I can reflect and see where I am today, compared to where I was before.
