Thanks to a connection between Scooter Kellum (Team Leader for Church and Leader Mobilization for the State Convention of Baptist in Indiana) and Chris Mills (Baptist Campus Ministries and Alabama Baptist State Board of Missions), this team of 16 college students and three adults chose to come together to serve in the ministries of New Life Ministries and with New Life Fellowship Church.

While in Indiana, the team completed multiple projects and served in many ways. One of their primary projects was serving at the New Life Community Meal Ministry. This group served lunch and dinner every day. "The students have enjoyed spending time at the Meal Ministry and talking with the people at the meal," shared Edwin Hocutt (Baptist Campus Minister at The University of Alabama in Huntsville). During their time serving, the group was able to build relationships with the patrons as they enjoyed meals together.

The group also taught devotions on Monday, Tuesday, and Thursday at the Men's Life House and Women's Life House. "The students enjoyed going into the homes to teach devotions. It was meaningful getting to meet the men and women and share their stories," explained Beth Gardner (Baptist Campus Minister at the University of South Alabama).

Outside of these primary responsibilities, the group helped paint areas within New Life Fellowship Church, completed projects in the building at 246 E. Franklin St., reorganize materials, tighten bunk beds, and replace light fixtures. They were also given the opportunity to help facilitate and participate in a blanket giveaway event with another organization in the community.

Although this group started as mostly strangers, they left with friendships and memories that will last a lifetime. They were also able to serve and make an impact that will continue to have a positive impact in the lives of those in our community.
