David spent eight months in the program rebuilding his foundation. While in the home, he completed the program requirements while also going above and beyond. After only six days in the program, he found full-time employment and continued working this job throughout his stay.

David also worked hard to take care of all of his legal issues. “I had a lifetime suspended license,” David shared. “But God provided a way with the help of a free lawyer who helped me get my license back with no restrictions.” Not only did David get his license back, but he also was able to purchase a car.

Education was also a priority for David while he was at the Men’s Life House. Not only did he complete the program required classes, but he completed extra classes on his own. With a smile, David went on to share, “I’m going back to school in November to get certified to become a recovery coach. I want to be able to help people like me.”

These are just a few highlights of all David accomplished while at the Men’s Life House. His future is bright and we look forward to seeing the good work he continues to do and how he can use what he learned to help others.

Before finishing our conversation, we asked David if he had any advice for current or future residents and he was quick to say, “This program is what you make it. It gives you the foundation and structure of a routine lifestyle and if you can obey the rules, then all the other things will start to fall into place. Don’t go against the grain. Be humble and be teachable.”
